I am very pleased to report that meetings of Richland County Council will be broadcast on the County's cable channel and live over the Internet, beginning on **March 6**. I am proud to have fulfilled this promise in sponsoring this motion, getting it approved and seeing it put into action.



PUBLIC SAFETY

I voted to approve an increase in the starting salary from \$30,000 per year to \$35,000 for deputies of the Richland County Sheriff's Department.



ENVIRONMENT

I was one of only two Council members to vote against extending the life of a landfill in Lower Richland by 30 years. I also sponsored a motion approved by Council to reduce the amount of waste it sends to landfills by up to 35 percent.



CREATING JOBS

In my first year on Council, creating more jobs has been an important priority. Richland County has won several recruiting battles which has brought in more than \$267 million in new investments that will create more than 600 new jobs!
